

# WELCOME TO SOCCER SHOTS



Thank you so much for joining us this Soccer Shots season! No matter what age or level your child will be playing at, please know that we at Soccer Shots recognize our unique opportunity to positively impact your child's life. We take the job of coaching children seriously. Our caring team will provide best in class coaching, curriculum and communication to ensure that your Soccer Shots session quickly becomes the highlight of your young player's week. ## Minis (2-3 years)

...is our high-energy program introducing children to soccer principles, such as using your feet, dribbling and the basic rules of the game. Through fun games, songs, and positive reinforcement, children will begin to experience the joy of playing soccer and being active.

## Classic (3-5 years)

...utilizes creative and imaginative games to focus on basic soccer skills like dribbling, passing, and shooting. We also highlight a positive character trait each session such as respect, teamwork and appreciation.

## Premier (5-8 years)

...focuses on individual skill, fitness and sportsmanship, providing an opportunity for children to be challenged through fun games and team interaction. Children will also be introduced to competition in a developmentally appropriate manner.

## When will my child be playing?

Please check your registration receipt for the time that your child will be playing! If there is any confusion or a mistake, please let us know!

## What should my child bring?

The only requirement is that your child wears closed toed sneakers on soccer day and dress them comfortably and for the weather (if playing outdoor).

## How do I get a jersey?

All players receive one new Adidas jersey, when paying the one-time yearly registration fee, similar to that pictured to the right! Extra jerseys can be purchased by returning players as needed.

## What about facilities?

Your school has designated a space on-site for us to set up and run classes each week!

## How does this all work?

Once your child is registered, his or her name will appear on the coach's roster and the children will be picked up with other teammates at the same time each week for class. When class is over, the coach will return the children to their classrooms. Be sure to check your email for weekly session summaries!
